

**SNAP STUDY Competition (“COMPETITION”)  
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**The Competition is subject to these Terms and Conditions (“T’s and C’s”), as may be amended from time to time. Please read the T’s and C’s carefully and pay special attention to all the terms printed in bold.**

**1. PROMOTER**

- 1.1 Boston City Campus and 2 Degrees Properties Pty Ltd (Registration No: 2017/665219/07), managed by JHI Retail (Pty) Ltd (Registration No.: 2013/192532/07) in its capacity as the property manager and Excellerate Brand Management (Pty) Ltd in its capacity as marketing service provider, are collectively the Promoters of this competition (collectively referred to as **“the Promoters”**).
- 1.2 The Promoters will make final and binding decisions in respect of all matters relating to the results of the Competition, including any disputes relating to the Competition and shall not be obliged to provide reasons for any decisions so taken.
- 1.3 The Promoters reserve the right to amend, modify and/or change the T's and C's at any time and will make the amended T's and C's available as set out in 5.1 below.

**2. COMPETITION RULES**

- 2.1 The Competition is open to all residents and citizens of South Africa (**“Participant(s)”**) who are in possession of a valid identity document or valid passport, except for any director or senior manager of the Promoters, the marketing service providers and/or any person who directly or indirectly controls or is controlled by the Promoters, including their spouses, life partners, business partners or immediate family members. A minor who enters the competition may only do so with his/her parent’s/legal guardian’s consent.
  - 2.2 The Competition runs from **15 March 2021** and closes at **18h00 on 30 April 2021 (“Competition Period”)**. The Promoters reserve the right to amend, modify, change, postpone, suspend or cancel this Competition and/or Prize (which has not been subject to a draw) or any aspect thereof, at any time and for whatsoever reason without further notice.
  - 2.3 Any entry by a Participant is subject to these T’s and C’s and by entering this Competition, all Participants agree to be bound by them.
- 2.5 A Participant may:
- 2.5.1 spend at any store at any of the following participating malls namely Sandton City / Nelson Mandela Square, Eastgate Shopping Centre, Liberty Midlands Mall, Liberty Promenade and Botshabelo Mall (**“Participating Malls”**);
  - 2.5.2 submit one entry per till slip which must reflect a minimum spend of R250 (Two hundred and fifty Rand) per till slip, attach the qualifying till slip to an entry form and drop the completed entry form in an entry box in the Participating Mall. There is no limit to the number of qualifying till slips which a Participant may submit;
  - 2.5.3 only submit till slips dated during the Competition Period.

### **3. PRIZES**

- 3.1 There are 5 (five) bursaries – 1 (one) per participating mall – to be won for the duration of the Competition Period for study towards 3 (three) year Boston City Campus degrees (“Boston Degree”), valued at approximately R150 000 (One hundred and fifty thousand Rand) each (“Prize”). 5 (five) Prize winners – 1 (one) per participating mall – will be chosen from a draw at each of the Participating Malls. Any dispute that arises as to the identity of the Prize winner as envisaged by this clause shall be adjudicated by a representative of the Promoter or an independent third party appointed by the Promoter, in its sole discretion.
- 3.2 If the Prize winner does not meet the requirements to study towards a Boston Degree, he/or she may choose to study towards a diploma or equivalent or where appropriate school studies as offered by the accredited institutions forming part of Boston and Ivy Schools.
- 3.3 The Prize winner may transfer the Prize to a third party who meets the requirements to study towards a Boston Degree or diploma or equivalent or where appropriate school studies (“**Third Party Beneficiary**”); however, the Prize may not be transferred to an existing Boston City Campus student.
- 3.4 The Prize will only be activated on producing a copy of a bursary award letter and an ID Document/Driver’s License at time of registration.
- 3.5 This Prize is only redeemable at Boston and the Prize winner or Third Party Beneficiary will be required to comply with the rules and regulations of Boston City Campus contained in the Registration Contract’s Terms and Conditions and the Annual Student Rulebook.
- 3.6 The Prize may not be redeemed for cash.
- 3.7 Registration fees, external fees, travel costs, text books and stationery expenses are not covered by the Prize.
- 3.8 Each Prize is for the full value stipulated above. Should the Prize winner or Third Party Beneficiary select a course that exceeds this value, the additional cost will be for the Prize winners or Third Party Beneficiary’s own account.
- 3.9 The Prize cannot be used towards existing outstanding fees at Boston City Campus.
- 3.10 Registration and activation of the Prize must be completed no later than 3 (three) years from the date of issue of the Prize.
- 3.11 In the event of poor academic performance, the cost of repeating a module/s will be for the Prize winner or Third Party Beneficiary.
- 3.12 The Prize winner or Third Party Beneficiary will forfeit the Prize if he/she is found to be in any contravention of the rules and regulations of Boston City Campus contained in the Registration Contract’s Terms and Conditions and the Annual Student Rulebook.

### **4. PUBLICITY AND DATA PRIVACY:**

- 4.1 By entering, a Participant acknowledges and gives express consent on entry that personal information, including without limitation, name, age, address (including postcode), telephone number and/or email address (“**Personal Data**”) may be used in connection with the

Competition and will be shared with the Promoters and their agents to the extent necessary to conduct the Competition.

- 4.2 All Personal Data relating to the Participants will be used solely in accordance with the Consumer Protection Act 68 of 2008, the Protection of Personal Information Act , and will not be disclosed to any third party, except for the purpose of the Competition where applicable unless the Participants gave their express consent to this on entry.

**5. GENERAL:**

No fees will be payable in this regard. The Prize winner will be given the opportunity to decline the publication of their images. The Prize winners' names and photographs may also be published by the Participating Malls in any internal/ external advertising, promotional material and/or digital and broadcast media for this promotion and any other future promotions without claim to compensation.
- 5.3 The Promoters do not make any representations or give any warranties, whether express or implied, that the Participant's participation in this Competition will necessarily result in the Participant winning a Prize.
- 5.4 To the extent permissible in law, the Promoters are not responsible and cannot be held liable for any loss or damages of whatsoever nature, howsoever arising, as a result of the Participant's participation in the Competition.
- 5.5 To the fullest extent permitted in law, by participating, the Participant indemnifies, releases and agrees to hold harmless the Promoters, their associated, holding and subsidiary companies, and its directors, officers, agents, representatives, shareholders, employees, successors and assigns from any and all claims or liability arising from their participation in the Competition, any Competition-related activity and/or acceptance, receipt, possession or use/misuse of any Prize awarded.
- 5.6 Participants are obliged to comply with all applicable laws, including those laws protecting the intellectual property rights of other parties.
- 5.7 The Prize winner or Third Part Beneficiary will also be required to comply with these terms and conditions and to accept same prior to registration for the course, failing which the Prize winner or Third Party Beneficiary will not be allowed to redeem the Prize.
- 5.8 These T's and C's will be construed, interpreted and enforced in terms of South African law.
